

SCHOOL RULES

GENERAL RULES

1. DOORS WILL NOT BE OPENED BEFORE 8:00 AM. If an emergency arises and a student must come earlier than **8:00**, **PRIOR ARRANGEMENTS MUST BE MADE WITH THE SCHOOL OFFICE.**
2. Chewing gum, mints, candy, etc. are not permitted because of the damage they have caused in books, furniture, clothes, etc.
3. Throwing rocks, sticks, snow, ice or any object that could cause bodily harm is strictly prohibited anywhere on the premises.
4. Electronic devices of any kind (including cell phones) are **NOT** permitted.
5. Board games, Uno cards, puzzles, coloring books, word finds, crossword puzzle books, checkers, chess and trivia games are permitted for use during recess.
6. Students will be permitted to use the school telephone during the day **only in cases of emergency**. No calls will be allowed to ask for permission to go to someone's house to play or to obtain homework, reports, gym sneakers or other forgotten items when the student had previous knowledge that they were needed.
7. Classroom and lab computers are to be used only with teacher supervision.
8. In traveling through hallways, please be considerate of others who are in class by being as quiet as possible.
9. For students participating in extra-curricular activities, written notification of transportation arrangements must be given daily prior to the activity. **Notes must be handed in at the beginning of the day.**

HOMEROOM

Homeroom period is a QUIET time for getting ready for the day.

1. Upon entering the building, bus students are to go directly to their classrooms.
2. Students will hang up their coats and backpacks, and then quietly take their places. Time should be spent getting books and supplies ready for the day.

5. All food is to be eaten in the cafeteria.

LATE BUS – GENERAL RULES

1. If a student, who regularly rides a bus, is going to be picked up as a walker, a note must be brought in from the parents and signed by the principal.
2. When waiting for late buses, students must wait with their assigned bus group.
3. When boarding buses, students line up from Kindergarten through 8th grades.
